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## Women and the Federal National Council (FNC)

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In the first ever Federal national Council (FNC) elections, women comprised **22%** of the overall members. One Emirati woman won a seat representing the Emirate of Abu Dhabi in the UAE's first electoral experience in **2006**. Eight more women were later appointed as FNC members.

Also in **2006**, the Electoral College list had **6,595** members including **1,162** women, and **65** women contested the elections – accounting for **14.25%** of the total **456** candidates.

In **2011** women made up **46%** of the **130,000** Emiratis eligible to take part in the Federal National Council elections through voting or nomination.

A total of **468** candidates across all emirates, including **85** women (**18%**), contested the election in **2011**. The final tally of female candidates in each emirate was: Abu Dhabi **22**; Dubai **26**; Sharjah **16**; Ras Al Khaimah **9**; Ajman **5**; Umm Al Quwain **4** and Fujairah **3**.

Shaikha Al Arai from Umm Al –Quwain won the elections, and Dr. Amal Al Qubaisi, Noora Al Kabi were appointed from Abu Dhabi, as well as Afra Al Basti and Dr. Mona Al Bahar from Dubai. Shaikha AL Owais was appointed from Sharjah, and Aysha Al Yamahi from Fujairah. All the **7** female members brought the percentage of female participation to **17.5%** of the **40** members of FNC.

It is also worth mentioning that in **2011**, for the first time in the history of the UAE, the government appointed Dr. Amal Al Qubaisi as the vice president of the FNC to become the first women holding this position not only in the UAE but also across the GCC countries.

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For the first time since its inception, UAE women participated in the FNC membership in the **14th** legislative chapter. One Emirati woman won a seat in the first electoral experience in **2006**. Eight more women were later appointed as FNC members, a percentage that is one of the highest worldwide. They are:

## Women in Leading Positions

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UAE women held many leading ministerial positions in the UAE. Her Excellency Sheikha Lubna bint Khalid Al Qasimi, now Minister of Foreign trade was previously Minister of economic and Planning in **2004**, and is the country's first female minister. In **2008**, there were four female ministers out of **25 - 16%**.

In **2009**, H.E. Sheikha Najla Mohammed Al Qasimi and H.E Dr. Hessa Abdullah Al Otaiba were appointed as UAE Ambassadors to the Kingdom of Sweden and Spain, respectively, marking another unprecedented step in the UAE's history. Until **2010**, the UAE's female ambassadors included three in ambassador roles and one as consul general.

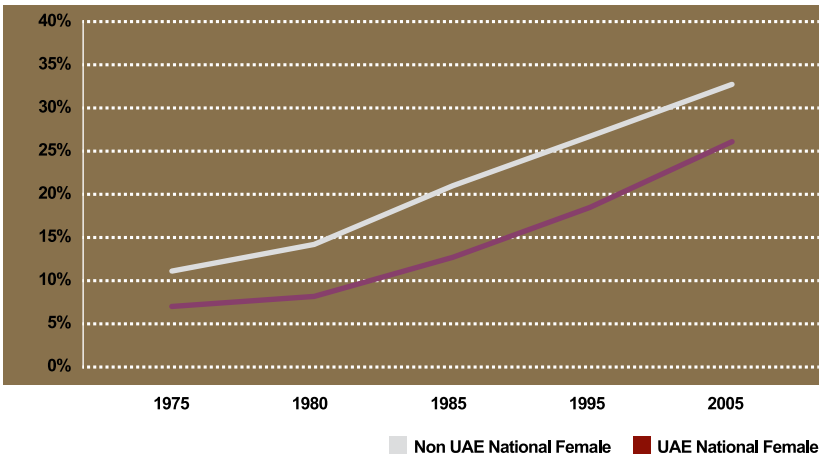

Figure 1: Participation of Women in Labor Force (15 years and over) - 1975 to 2005

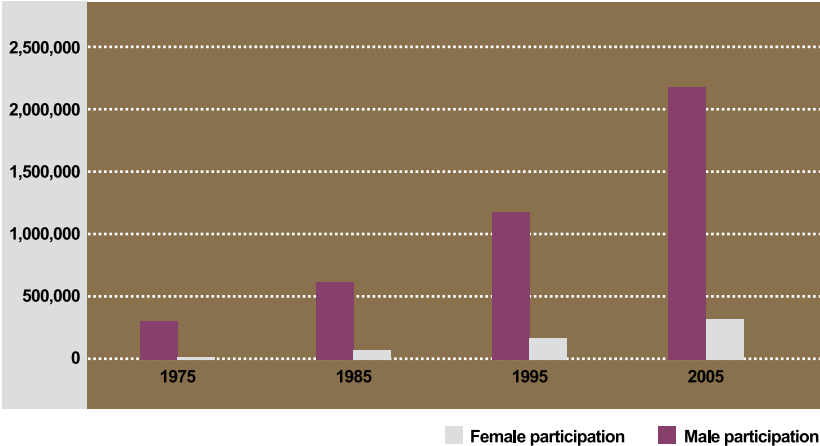

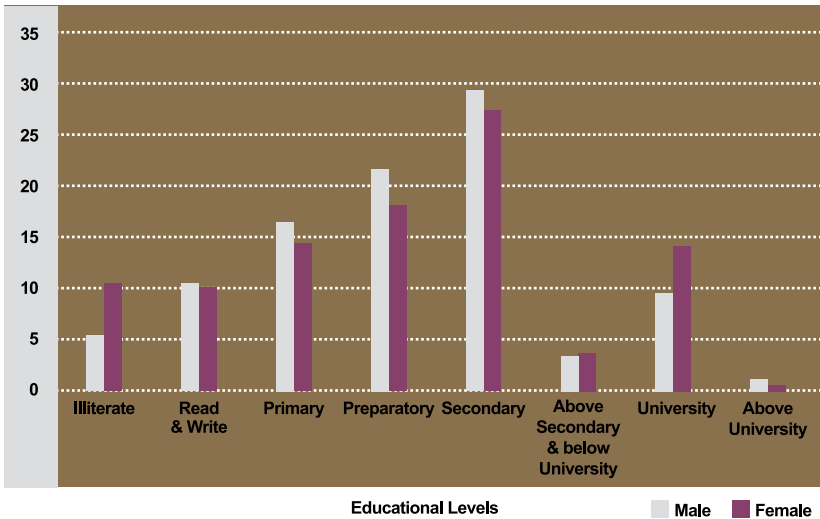

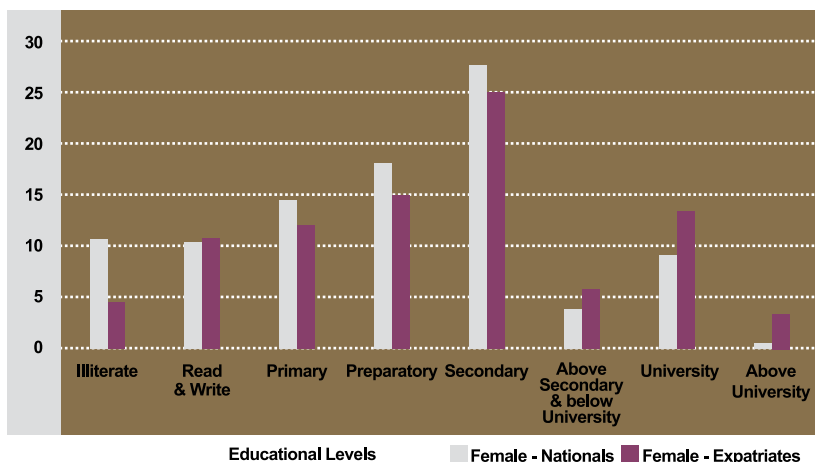

Data indicates that the illiteracy rate among females (10.6%) is twice that of males (5.4%); there is a variance between males and females in literacy and all the educational levels. After the secondary level until the “above university” level the rate of females exceeds that of the males, and decreases again at “above university” level.

Statistics mark the relative variance between female Nationals and Expatriates in the in most of the educational stages and illiteracy with the biggest difference being in the university stage.

Figure 3: Female Representation in the Economically Active Segment

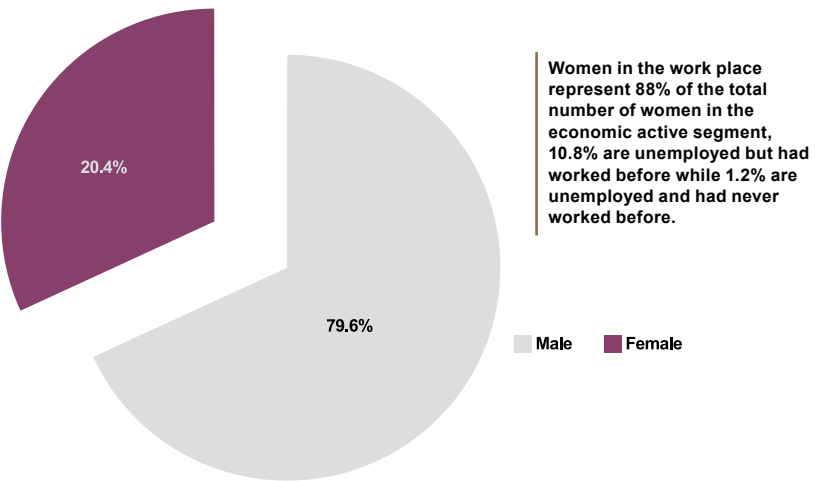
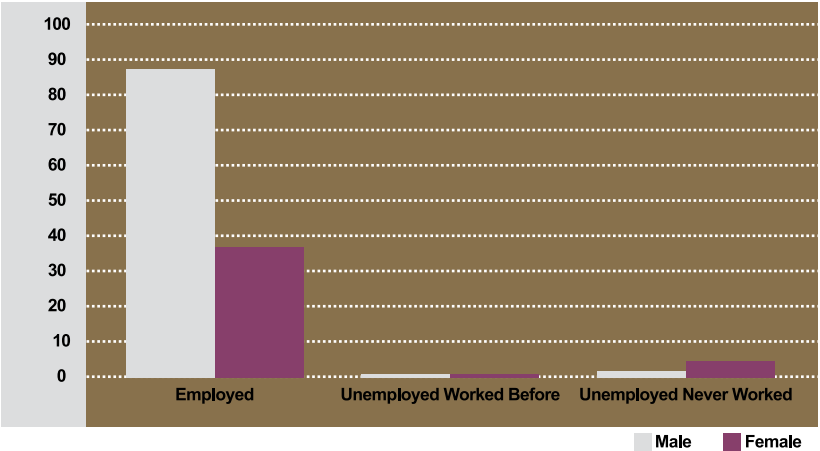


Figure 4: Comparison between economically active males and females



The economically active segment represents 72.6% of the population; with males representing 89.4% of the segment and females 41.8%.

Above is a comparison between males and females; employed, those who have never worked before and unemployed but worked before. There is a vast difference of 50.8% between males and females in the labor force, while the rate, 0.5%, of unemployed but worked before is equal, and a difference of 3.3% in the unemployed but never worked before segment.



Figure 5: Female Representation in the Economically Inactive Segment

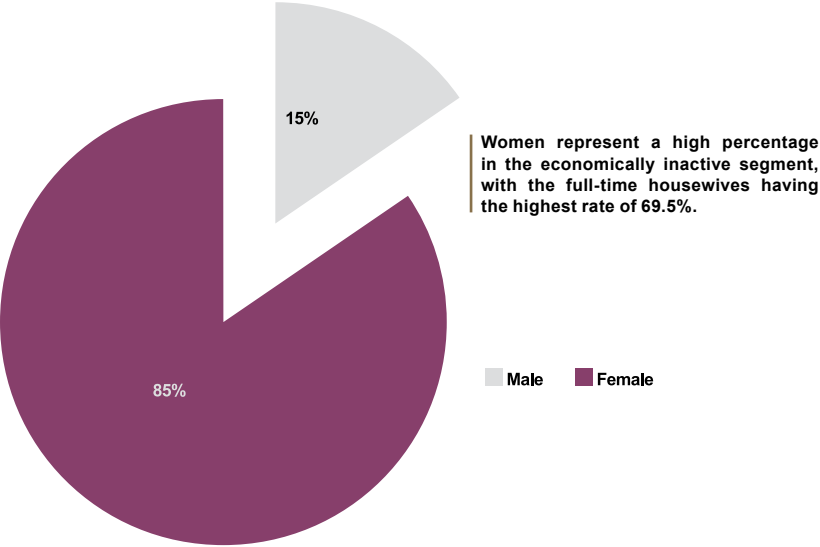
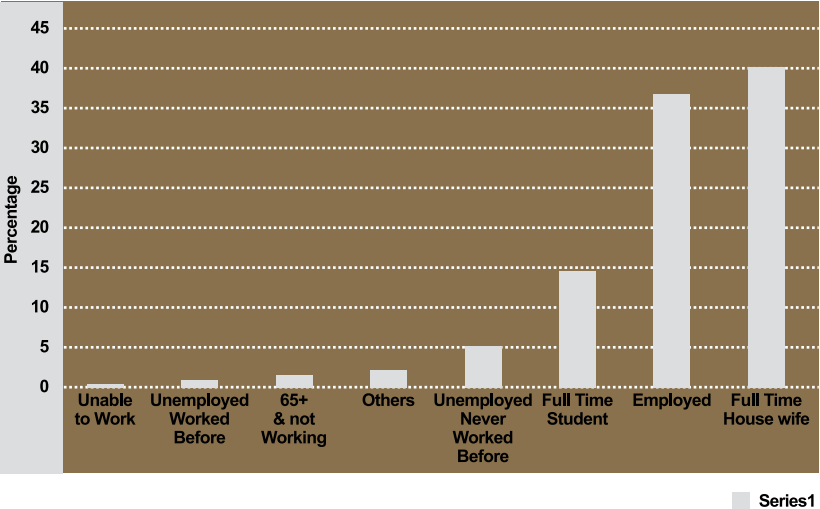


Figure 6: Female Distribution According to Activity Status



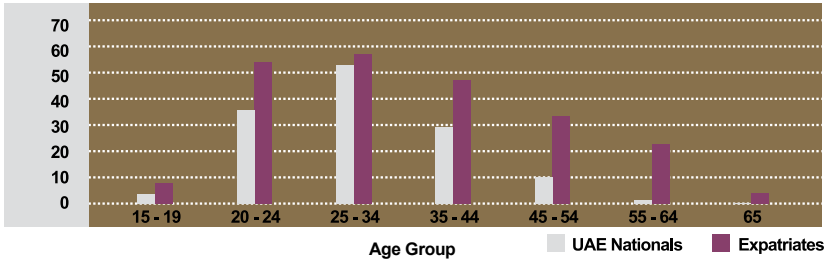
As shown in the above chart, the full-time housewife segment has the largest rate of females, followed by the employed segment with a slight difference rate of 3.7% between the two segments.

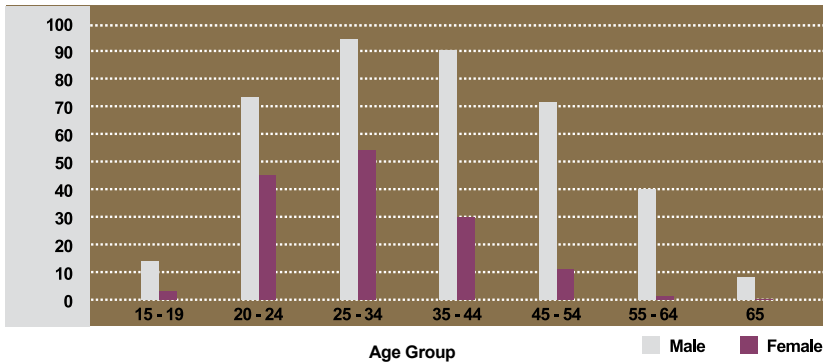

**Figure 7: Economic activity between female Nationals and female Expatriates according to age group**



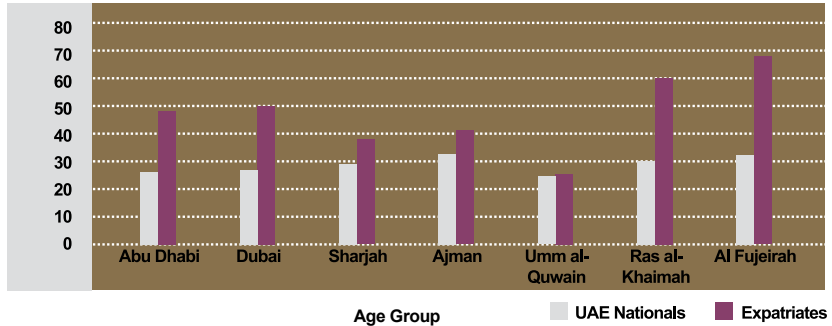
The economic activity of female nationals and expatriates is at its peak in the age group of 25-34 years. This declines gradually with older age, but with higher rates amongst female nationals, with a drop of 23.9% between the age groups 25-34 and 35-44.

There is a big difference between the economically active female and male nationals in most age groups, with the biggest difference being in the age group 35-44, in which the rate of economically active women generally decreases.

The rate of the economically active female nationals is relatively close between all the emirates, while there is slight variance amongst female expatriates; with them having the highest rate in Fujairah, and double the rate of economic active UAE nationals in both Fujairah and Ras Al Khaimah.

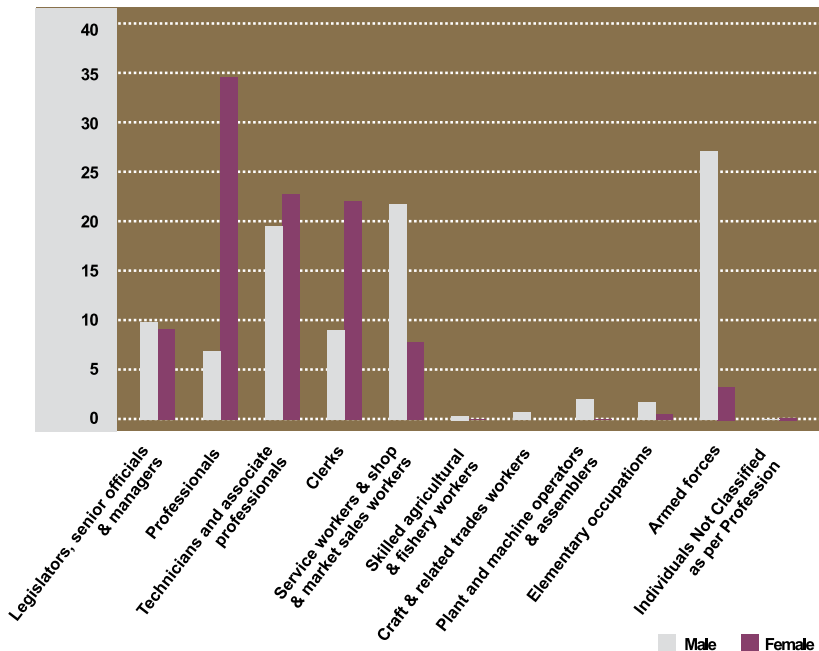

The records show that the distribution of employed population is highest in the paid workers segment amongst males and females, UAE Nationals and Expatriates. The UAE National females have the highest rate amongst the paid workers (99.2) followed by the female Expatriates. Furthermore, males, UAE Nationals and expatriates, outrun females in the employer segment with a 2.9%. And in the self-employed segment, we find a slight variance between UAE Nationals and Expatriates, and likewise between males and females.

The statistical data represented in the above chart show that UAE economically active female nationals are mostly concentrated in the “scientific, technical and humanitarian professionals” segment followed by the technicians and associate professors of the same field segment, and directly, with a small difference rate, the “clerks” segment comes next. There is generally a big difference rate between males and females in two segments; “scientific, technical and humanitarian professionals” and “clerks”, where there is a higher concentration of female employees, with a completely different scenario in the “service workers & shop & market sales workers” and the “armed forces” segments where the concentration of male employees is higher. When looking at the “Legislators, senior officials & managers” segment, we find an insignificant difference rate of 1.1% between males and females, which highlights the growth of women generally in the managing field. Moreover, when considering the economic activities, we find that the rate of females is mainly higher in the fields that do not exceed 48 working hours per week.

The rate of economically active female nationals is mostly higher in the Education sector (32.1%) and the Public Administration and Defence; Compulsory Social Security sector (23.2%). When studying the tables which display the percentage of employed population according to the specified working hours, we find that the economic activities mentioned above represent the second and third most active activity amongst the economic active population. Financial Intermediation represents the third economic active sector for female working nationals (10.8%), which represents the fifth active sector (86.0%) amongst the economic activities occupied by UAE national females. Based on the percentage of employed population by economic activity according to specified actually worked hours, the 'less than or equal to 48 hours' group holds the largest number of employed population and which basically represents the Government and Private sector working hours and has the largest number of working male and female national employees.

According to the 2008 data, the ratio of male and female nationals is relatively high in the government federal and local sectors, where they exceed the 90% with lower contribution in other sectors.

The table shows that the percentage of female working nationals in the private sector exceeds the male ratio by 2% with a noticeable difference between female nationals and expatriates, equivalent to 25%.

After studying the employment rate according to the age groups it is very clear that the age groups (24-25 years) and (35-44) are the most dominant in the labor market among the male and female nationals and expatriates, with higher activity rates amongst expatriates in the age groups (45-54) and (55-64). The age group (25-34) represents the most active group amongst the female employment rates with a 12% difference between nationals and expatriates. Furthermore, the age group (20-24) portrays the biggest difference between female employees, nationals and expatriates. There is a noticeable difference rate among all age groups on the ratio of male and female employees with the lowest ratio amongst the 25-34 age groups.

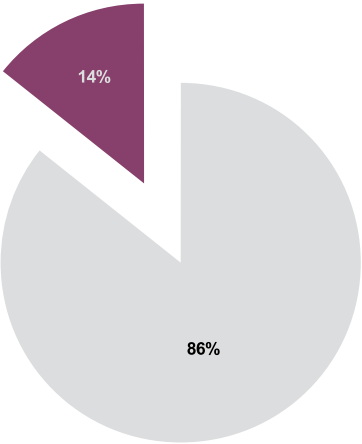

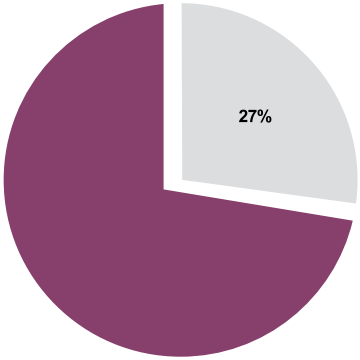
**Figure 11: Unemployment rates between males and females who have worked before**

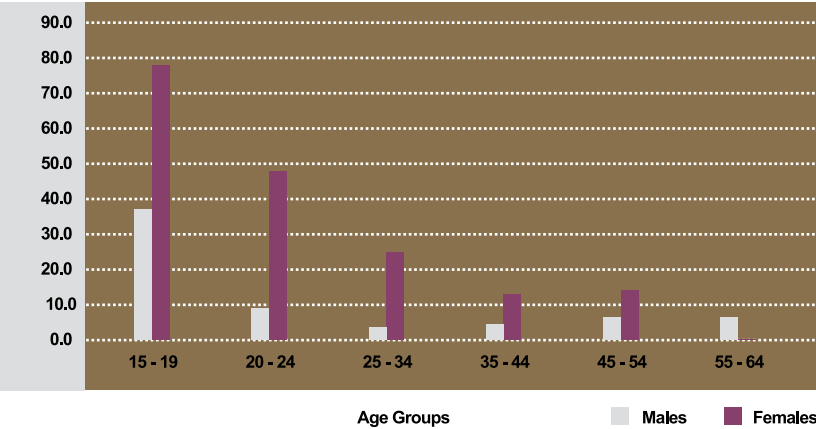

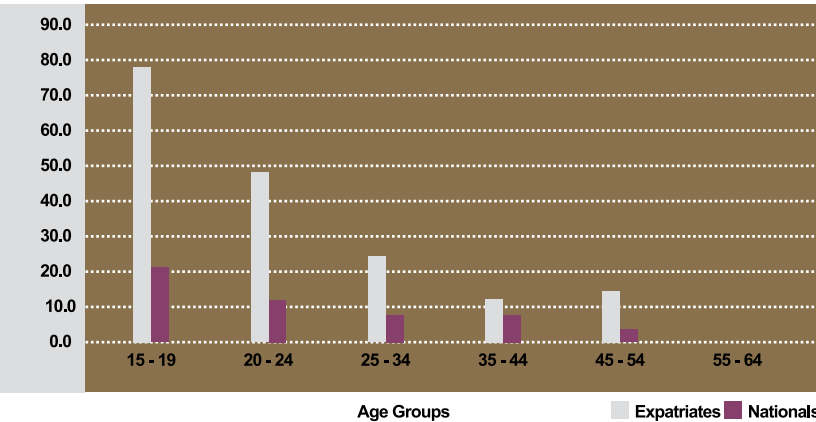

The unemployment rate is generally higher between both genders in the age group 15-19 but with women proceeding with a 78.6%. The unemployment rate decreases within the age group 20-24 to approximately 30% in both genders, but with a considerably high rate of unemployment amongst females (48.2%) and lower steady rates within the 25-34 and 35-44 age groups.

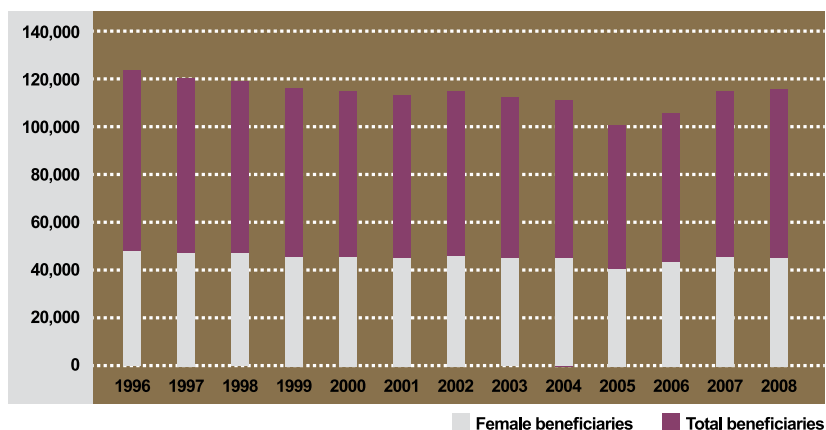

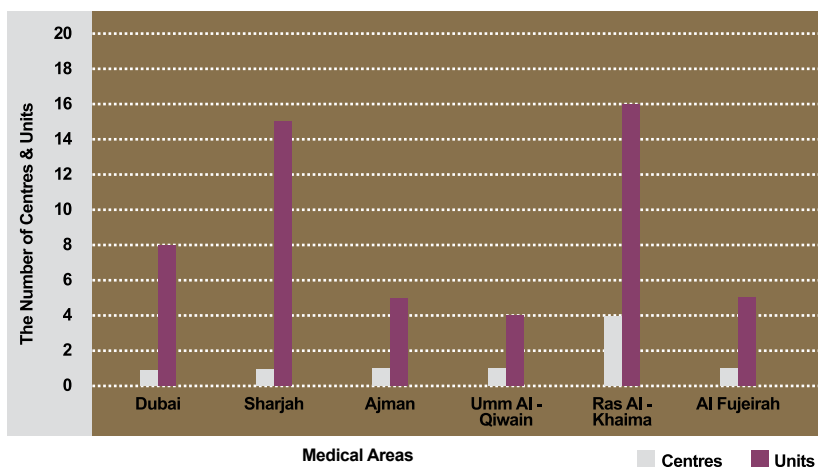
